

# Waiting in Anticipation

We have some of the same feelings as the first disciples of Jesus did. In a very short time they had witnessed the death and burial of Jesus. Then they were overjoyed by the resurrection of Jesus and were celebrating



the fact that he was with them again. Now they were hearing Jesus telling them "not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the 'promise of the Father. . . but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit."

We have been on an emotional roller coaster in our Area Faith Communities the last couple weeks too. We have celebrated with our second graders as they made their First Communion. This always brings family and friends together for a big celebration. Our pastor, Fr. Tony Stubeda, died on Monday, April 29th. Even though we knew that this day was likely coming soon, we continued praying for a miracle healing. We

certainly could identify with the disciples on that first Good Friday. The joy of Easter and the resurrection changed many things for them. The joy and blessing of our young people receiving Jesus in Holy Communion for the first time changes many things for them too.

Last Sunday evening we were reminded of the fact that Fr. Tony has died. He is no longer with us. Monday we celebrated his funeral Mass in his home parish of St. Philip's in Litchfield. We feel like the disciples when Jesus told them that he needed to return to the Father. That needed to happen so that the Holy Spirit could come. We trust in Jesus and his love for us. He will continue to provide for us.

We are also mindful of Mother's Day on Sunday. Motherhood is a special gift that God showers on all of us. Our mothers not only give us life, but they continue to provide nurturing, guidance and spiritual direction far beyond the day of our birth. We pause to thank God for our mothers and to praise God for all mothers and mothers-to-be. We pray especially for mothers who are no longer with us. May we acknowledge and appreciate all mothers who are still with us.
