**Liturgy** – Email reminders will be sent out before the weekend Mass to remind the Servers, Lectors, Communion Servers, etc. to serve and if they cannot make it to find a replacement. Father Paul working on getting people to help with Holy Week liturgies.

**Environment Committee** – church decorating went well for Lent and we have received lots of great compliments on the simplicity of the look and that the inside, outside and basement of church all co-ordinate in color and style. Upcoming dates for decorating are: Palm Sunday set up on Sat, March 27 at 9 AM. Holy Thursday set up time is Wed, March 31<sup>st</sup> at 8 PM. Good Friday set up time is after Holy Thursday Mass, approx 9:30 PM. Easter Sunday set up at 9 AM on Saturday, April 3<sup>rd</sup>.
