

### **Cleaning Out the Clutter**

There were two places in my home at Glencoe that had a tendency to collect clutter and disorganization. When I was in Kandiyohi I did not have a desk that would accommodate my computer, so I bought myself a



very nice computer desk. It had space for a computer, a printer and a high back with compartments for papers and other things one might need when working. The problem was that in Glencoe I really didn't need the desk in my home office as there was already one there, and I no longer had a PC, but a laptop. The top of the desk and the little cubbyholes collected papers, pictures, cards, memos and other things I didn't really know what to do with. The other magnet of disorganization was the closet in my home office. On one side it had a chest of drawers and on the other it was mostly open with shelves on one side. Across the whole top there was a shelf. The drawers began to be stuffed full of knick-knacks that I didn't put out anymore, cards that I someday intended to send, cords for long lost appliances, old phones, old glasses and broken

or unused picture frames. On the other side I had a collection of gift bags that I would never use, because I prefer to wrap presents, but seemed to be too nice to throw away. Since I wrap presents, I also save boxes that might come in handy sometime. Needless to say it was an awful mess, and I had a hard time finding what I needed. In the end, all of these things were in the way, caused me consternation and made it harder to do what I would have liked to do.

Today's Gospel presents us with the story of the cleansing of the temple. It is clear that Jesus has come to complete and overturn the way people approach God. The sacrifices necessary in the present time are to be replaced by the sacrifice of Jesus. Jesus sweeps away all that stands between us and the experience of the mercy of God.

One of the great challenges of Lent is seeing what things we have placed between ourselves and an encounter with the mercy and compassion of Christ. Have we filled the closets of our lives with habits that protect us from the recognition of our need for God? Have we filled the cubbyholes of our spirits with comfortable pleasures that make us feel good, but don't really fill us with joy? The season of Lent invites us to take the sometimes fearful step of letting the Lord into our lives. We ask him to help us clear away the things that stand between us and His mercy. We take the risk that He will overturn our comfort, sweep away our illusory riches and destroy the barriers of ignorance that protect us. We do this trusting that His mercy and compassion will restore, renew and transform our lives. It seems to be a risky move, but as St. Paul reminds us, "the foolishness of God is wiser than human wisdom, and the weakness of God is stronger than human strength." If we open the closet doors of our lives, he will fill them with compassion, mercy and joy.
