Columbarium Construction – Quentin

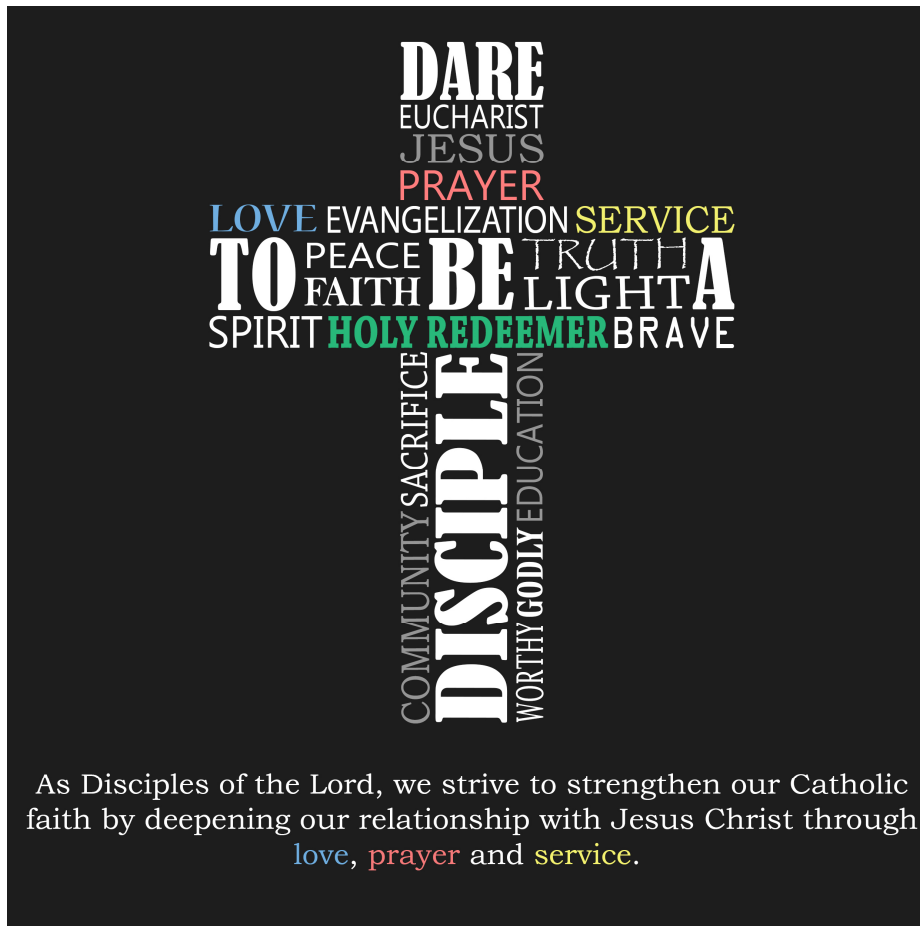
- Columbarium's will be set tomorrow morning – July 18th.
